

WEST LINN ARTS FESTIVAL

Prospectus & Application

The 11th Annual West Linn Arts Festival is open to all Northwest artists and craftspeople producing original art. Commercially produced work, art assembled from kits, or imported art and goods will not be accepted. The festival seeks the finest quality artwork through a selection by jury.

The festival's mission is to present a premier art festival which promotes the arts within the community of West Linn and offers support to the West Linn High School Art Department as the recipient of our charitable contribution this year.

Artwork Submission

The Festival is open to all Northwest artists. A non-refundable jury fee of \$15.00 must accompany all applications.

Artists interested in applying are requested to supply (4) digital images of their current work and (1) booth display on CD in JPEG format only. Submitted images must be representative of artwork to be displayed at the festival. Images should be at a 300 dpi resolution and no larger than 1024 x 768 pixels.

The CD should be marked clearly and legibly with the artist's full name and medium. Please number your images 01 through 04 and the booth image 05. Be sure to include your last name and first initial on each submitted image (Example: jones.a.01.jpg). The CD will be returned to artists who provide a self-addressed stamped envelope.

West Linn Arts Festival reserves the right to use selected images for publicity and promotion purposes, with credit given to the artist.

Selection Process

A panel of jurors consisting of experienced art professionals makes selections based solely on the quality, originality and creativity of work represented by the images submitted by each artist. Final selection is based on the combination of jury results and an allotted number of participants in each medium.

Booth Fees

Booth fees are \$200.00 for a 10' x 10' space. Double booths and corner booths are available by request on a first-come-first-serve basis. Booth fees are due within 30 days of notification of acceptance. Booth fees for accepted artists must be postmarked no later than June 10th, 2010.

Up to two accepted artists are permitted to share a 10' x 10' single booth. Please submit both applications and jury fees together if sharing a booth.

Artists' Marketplace

This outdoor festival is held in the beautiful Willamette Park along the Willamette River in West Linn, Oregon. The Artists' Marketplace features approximately 85 artist booths located in the center of the park. Festival Hours are:

10:00 am - 6:00 pm Saturday, September 11th

10:00 am - 5:00 pm Sunday, September 12th

Artists are strongly encouraged to donate a piece of their work for a Silent Auction to benefit the West Linn High School Arts Department.

Other Attractions

West Linn High School Art Booth, Food vendors, National and Regional Music Entertainment, Stage Acts, Performance Art and an Artist Hospitality Booth.

Booth Structure

Artists must provide their own booth and be prepared for all weather conditions. Electricity is not available and generators are not allowed.

Security

Security is provided Friday and Saturday nights. Artists are ultimately responsible for the security of their work at all times.
